

- ❖ Families with multiple children attending Camp Vick or Pathfinder Lodge this summer, each sibling may deduct \$20.
- ❖ Avoid late fees of \$20 by registering (via mail) at least 2 weeks before the camp session begins; or \$25 if registering at camp.
- ❖ FULL PAYMENT is due 14 days before the beginning of the camp session.
