

RETREATS & EVENTS

Pathfinder Lodge is located on the eastern shores of Otsego Lake approximately 5 miles from the village of Cooperstown, NY. Activities include swimming, boating, hiking, beachside campfires, sports, games, nature study, and arts & crafts. Pathfinder Lodge has cabin-style accommodations and can accommodate tents and small campers.

Camp Vick is in Freedom, NY and sits on over 200 acres that include rolling hills, mixed forests, and Skim Lake. Activities enjoyed at Camp Vick include camping, swimming in our inground pool (subject to availability), canoeing, hiking, campfires, sports, games, nature study, and arts & crafts.

Both sites have classroom spaces, outdoor learning areas, a multipurpose (ball) field, and a full dining hall. Chapel services and Bible studies can be inside or at the peaceful and picturesque outdoor Chapel area. We are available for camping, retreats, family reunions, weddings, and events.

Start a family tradition at Camp Vick



Lifequard Training:

June 30-July 3 ages 15+

Class & Overnight Accommodations \$325 (Class Only \$250)

This four-day training will equip participants with the knowledge and certifications necessary to be a lifeguard at a pool or lake. Certifications include First Aid, CPR/AED and the Waterfront module. Meals during class time are included for all registrants. Overnight accommodations include three meals daily and a shared cabin.
